Mrs. Norder, Aged 95, Juda, Passes On
Native of Switzerland Dies Sunday at Juda After Long Illness

Monroe—Funeral services for Mrs. Leonard Norder, 95, who died Sunday afternoon at her home in Juda after a long illness, were held at 1:30 p. m. Wednesday in the Norder home for family and relatives and at 2 p. m. in Zion Evangelical United Brethren church, Juda.

The Rev. Peter Retzlaff officiated, and burial was in the Dutch Hollow cemetery.

The former Barbara Stauffacher was born in Switzerland and came to this country in 1864, settling in Sylvester township.

After her marriage to Leonard Norder Nov. 12, 1878, in Dutch Hollow, she continued residing in Sylvester township until moving to Juda in 1929. Mr. Norder died Aug. 14, 1941.

Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. John Haney, Sylvester township, Mrs. George Vance, Clear Lake, and Mrs. C. J. Eliason of Juda; a son, Frederick, Westby; six sisters, Mrs. Margaret Phillips, Pasadena, Calif., Mrs. Anna Wolten, Monroe, Mrs. Mary Babler and Mrs. Kathryn Pinnow, Renwick, Iowa, Mrs. Dorothy Hadler, Winneconne, and Mrs. Angie Peabody, Albany; four grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren, and five great-great-grandchildren.

She was a member of the Juda Evangelical United Brethren church and its women's missionary society.
