
George W. Norton, Sr. March 10, 1931 - March 5, 2024

George W. Norton, Sr., age 92, of rural Monticello passed away on Tuesday, March 5, 2024 at his home. He was born the son of Chester and Wretha (Figi) Norton on March 10, 1931 in Monroe. He was a graduate of Monroe High School. George was united in marriage to Doris M. Schuetz on October 11, 1953 in Monroe, sharing 70 years together.

Until his mid-40's he farmed the original Norton farm, south of Monroe. In 1971, along with his wife, he purchased an old abandoned farmstead near Monticello which he painstakingly restored.
