Services Held for A. R. Nottingham, 72, Detroit, Mich.

Private funeral services for Avon R. Nottingham, 72 years of age, Detroit, Mich., and St. Petersburg, Fla, who passed away on Tuesday of last week in his summer home on Lake Erie, were held at 2 Friday afternoon in Highland cemetery here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated.

Mr. Nottingham was born at Lawrence, Kans., May 5, 1882. A graduate of Lawrence, Kans., Engineering college, he received his M. E. degrees from the University of Wisconsin and Cornell University. He was a professor of engineering at Purdue University and was connected with the research department at Cornell University. Later, he was in the engineering department of General Motors Corp. of Detroit.

Mr. Nottingham was a charter member of the Sigma Xi honorary fraternity, a members of A.S.M.E., the S.A.E., and the A.S.P.E.E. engineering societies. He was also a member of the Masonic order and the Trinity Methodist church, Detroit.

He was married to the former Lea Kilgore, formerly of Monticello, in 1912.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Ralph, Cleveland, Ohio; three sisters, Daisy N. Ralston, Lawrence, Kans., Vesta Steward, Kansas. City, Mo. and Sara Pauly, Mountclair, N. J.; and two granddaughters.
