May 13, 1900 - January 19, 1967
Mrs. Pluss,66, Taken by Death

MONTICELLO (Times Special) — Mrs. Herman Pluss, 66, Route 1, Albany township, died unexpectedly this morning at 4:30 a. m. in her home after an acute heart attack.

Mrs. Pluss was the former Irene Rhyner, born on a farm in Mt. Pleasant Township on May 13, 1900. Her parents were Jacob and Sarah Freitag Rhyner. She received her education at the Fairview Rural School.

She was married on June 27, 1918, to Frank Kreuger. He died on Oct. 28 of the same year during the flu epidemic. She was married on Oct. 21, 1934, to Herman J. Pluss in the home of her parents.

They farmed on the Pluss farm for one year and then moved to the Rhyner homestead farm three miles west of Albany on Highway 39 and since then resided there.

Mrs. Pluss is survived by her husband, two sons, John Jacob and Clarence H. of rural Albany; five brothers, John Henry, Casper W., Wilbert, all of Albany, Alfred, Brodhead, Lloyd, New Glarus; three sisters, Mrs. Henry Blumer, Mrs. Joe Blumer, Mrs. Walter Pfeuti, Albany; and five grandchildren.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, the Albany Circle of the church, the Smiley's Mothers Club and the American Legion Auxiliary of Albany.
