John Pluss, 37, Dies August 26

John J. Pluss, age 37, Albany township, Route 1, Albany, died Monday, August 26 at 6 p.m. at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe. He became ill while on a family vacation in the Elroy-Sparta area, returned to his home and was admitted to the hospital Monday morning. Cause of his death was a massive cerebral hemorrhage.

He was born in Monroe, Wis., March 28, 1937, the son of Herman and Irene Rhyner Pluss. He graduated from Albany High School in 1955 and was married October 25, 1958 at Woodford, Wis. to Emogene Marti of the Woodford area. He has always farmed in Albany township and lived on the family homestead for the last five years.

Pluss is survived by his wife, his father and his stepmother, Herman and Clara Pluss, four sons all at home, Allan, 15, Roger, 13, David, 12 and Randall, 10, and one brother Clarence H. Pluss, R. 1, Albany. They farmed in partnership. He was preceded in death by his mother who died January 19, 1967.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, Green County Barbershop Chorus, Monroe, and the Albany township board. He was also president of Ad-A-Million farm club and also a member of the Fairview Community Club. Services will be conducted Thursday August 28, 1:30 p.m. at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Interment will be in the Highland Cemetery.

Visitation will be at the Zwingli Church Memorial lounge after 3 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday after 11 p.m. in the church sanctuary.
