

Alta M. Qualley

June 1, 1888 - February 9, 1981

Mrs. Alta M. Qualley, 92, Albany, died Monday, Feb. 9, in Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, following a long illness. She had been a resident of the nursing home for about four years.
