William Ramsey Succumbs at 89

William C. Ramsey, 89, Albany, father of Mrs. John Ball, Green County Welfare Department case worker, died at 2:42 a.m. today in St. Care hospital. He was admitted Sunday as a medical patient. He had been living at the home of his niece, Mrs. Roe Bartlett in Albany.

Mr. Ramsey was born in Marion, Kan., Aug. 1, 1875, the son of Alexander D. and Mary Ellen Noland Ramsey, early settlers of Kansas state. The family came to Green County in 1894. William C. was married Jan. 1, 1900 to Mary Ellen Jones. He farmed 2 1/2 miles north of Albany and later engaged in road construction work.

Surviving are the daughter; two sons, David Arley, Beloit, and William Robert, Dixon, Ill., and two grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a sister, Mrs. E. Q. Knapp, Oelwein, Ia., in 1955. His father died in 1906; his mother, July 17, 1929. A brother, Frank, died in infancy.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Sharer funeral home in Albany. Rev. Tom Chinn of the Methodist church will officiate. Burial is to be in the Attica Cemetery.
