Mrs Madge Reinitz, 84, W3842 County EE, rural Monticello, and a former Albany resident, died Sun. Jan. 11, 1987 at Pleasant View Nursing Home, where she had been a resident since Jan. 2, 1987.

Born June 17, 1902 in Albany Twp to Walter and Nettie (Williams) Jones.

Received her education in English Settlement Rural School, Albany Twp.

She married Howard Sutherland, who died in 1941. In April 1945 she married Carl Reinitz, who died in 1972. She had resided in CA and St Louis MO, as well as Albany. She lived in Albany during WWII and worked at the Burgess Battery Plant in Monroe. When in St Louis, she worked in a bakery and motel. She came back to Albany in 1974 and resided there until 1985, when she came to the Monticello area to reside with her foster daughter.

Survived by her foster daughter, Mrs Leroy (Joan) Spring, rural Monticello; a brother, Chester Jones, Albany; two grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
