Ernest Robert, Sr., 81, New Glarus, is Called; Rites Held

Funeral services for Ernest Robert, Sr., 81 years of age, who passed away last Wednesday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, following a number of months of declining health, were held at 2 Saturday afternoon in the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, New Glarus,

The Rev. Lynn F. B. Tschudy, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

Native of Switzerland

A native of Switzerland, he was born Aug. 20, 1871, in Neuchatel, LaChaud de Fond, the son of Paul and Anna Nydeggen Robert. He came to America in 1892, settling first in Nebraska. On July 4, 1899, Mr. Robert was united in marriage to Anna Blum, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. For many years Mr. and Mrs. Robert resided on a farm in Mt. Pleasant township, a few miles northeast of Monticello, now operated by a son, Ernest, Jr.

Following the death of Mrs. Robert in November, 1929, Mr. Robert moved to New. Glarus with a daughter, Helen.

Mr. Robert whose friends in the Monticello area numbered a great many, was a member of the New Glarus Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church,

In addition to the son, he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Arthur Doyle, New Glarus, with whom he made his home, and Mrs. Arthur Beinema, Monroe; a brother, Floria?, a half-brother Paul, and three sisters, Lena, Louise, and Emma, all in Switzerland, and five grandchildren. In addition to his wife, his parents and a sister preceded him in death.
