### **Rolph, Lumber Man Dies at Monticello**

MONROE — William V. Rolph, Monticello, passed away Monday morning at St. Mary's hospital, Janesville, where he has been confined the past two months suffering from an internal complaint.

Deceased was 59 years of age, a son of the late Charles and Mary Rolph, early settlers of Green county. He was a member of the firm of Rolph Brothers Lumber company, Monticello, and was among the leading business men of southern Wisconsin.

The following sisters and brothers survive: Mrs. Mary Burgg, Ellen and Lottie, Monticello; John of Buterman; Hiram, Freeport, Ill., an engineer on the Illinois Central railroad; Charles, Fred, George and Walter, all of Monticello.

The remains will be taken to Monticello, where Masonic funeral services will be conducted, Mr. Rolph being a member of that organization.
