Norman C. Rosen, 56, Former Local Man, Dies Suddenly

Funeral services for Norman C. Rosen, 56 years of age, former Monticello resident, who was pronounced dead upon arrival at the Beloit Memorial hospital at 5:30 am. Sunday, were held at 1 p.m. Wednesday in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

His death was attributed to a sudden heart attack at his home, 2080 Shopiere Road, Beloit.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highand cemetery here. Pallbearers were Robert Dearth, Monroe, Irving J. Eichorst, Sr., Mt. Horeb, M. J. Gonstead, Herbert Siepert, Warren Wagner, Beloit, and Dr. R. A. Woodruff, Monticello.

Frederick S. Voegeli was in charge of arrangements.

He was born in Minneapolis, Minn., Dec. 4, 1913, a son of John and Emilie Peterson Rosen. He attended schools at Shields, N. D., and graduated from the Sturgis, S. D., high school. He was united in marriage to Sylvia C. Iien in 1934. He was employed at the M. E. Lynn Hardware Co. here until 1955, when he suffered a heart attack and was forced to give up his work. Later he was employed as a bookkeeper at Dearth Motors, Monroe. Mr. and Mrs. Rosen moved to Beloit in 1965 and Mr. Rosen had since been employed as an accountant with Siepert & Co.

While in Monticello Mr. Rosen was active in community affairs and in Boy Scout work, acting as Assistant Scoutmaster for many years.

Mr. Rosen was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

He is survived by his wife; one son, Gordon R., Grand Rapids, Mich.; one daughter, Mrs. Thomas L. (Ardyce) Heuer, Hoffman Estates, Ill; two sisters, Mrs. Fred Christensen, Sturgis, S. D., and Mrs. Alice McCormick, Seattle, Wash., and eight grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, two sisters, and a granddaughter, Sandra Heuer, July 21, 1963.
