MONTICELLO — Sylvia .C. Rosen, 68, 114 Urban Road, Monticello, died at 9:08 am, Feb. 2, 1984, in St. Clare Hospital. She was admitted to the hospital Wednesday afternoon after suffering a massive cerebral hemorrhage at her home.

Born Feb. 1, 1916 in Freda, N.D., she was the daughter of Selmer and Christine Gilbertson Lien.

A graduate of Freda High School, she was married to Norman C. Rosen on Nov. 9, 1934. They came to the Blanchardville area in 1938, moved to Monticello. in 1940 and to Beloit in 1965. After her husband's death on Aug. 2, 1970, Mrs. Rosen attended Blackhawk Technical School, returning to the Monticello area in 1973. She also worked as a receptionist for the Gonstead Clinic in Monroe and Beloit for 18 years.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. T. L. (Ardyce) Heuer, Hoffman Estates, Ill.; one brother, Otis C. Lien, Cheyenne Wells, Colo.; two sisters, Mrs. Thomas (Crystal) Brusveen, Monticello and Mrs. Ralph (Dorothy) Einerson, Ft. Pierce, Fla. and nine grandchildren.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her mother in 1957; her father in 1978; two brothers, Kermit in 1970 and Howard in 1978; one son, Gordon, in 1981 and a granddaughter, Sandra Heuer in 1963.

The deceased was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello and its Home Missionary Society. She also enjoyed working with plants and flowers.

Funeral services will be held at 2 pm. Saturday, at Zwingli United Church of Christ with the Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
