

Earl W. Sarbacker

June 22, 1916 - November 26, 2007

Age 91 of Browntown, WI died Monday, November 26, 2007 at the Monroe Clinic Hospital. Earl was born on June 22, 1916 in Montrose Township, Dane County, Wisconsin, the son of William John and Irene (Skelly) Sarbacker. He attended Paoli and Belleville area schools. Earl and Helen Miller were married June 18, 1940 in Dubuque, Iowa.
