Mrs. Schilt, 77, Rites Thursday

Mrs. Rudolph Schilt, 77, of 1819 10th Ave., died at 4 this morning (Aug. 22) in the Monroe Manor Nursing Home. She had been ill since March and was at The Manor on Aug. 2. Her husband is living there.

The former Anna K. Moser, daughter of Michael and Susan Zimmerman Moser, was born in Spring Grove Township, Green County, June 18, 1890. She attended Monroe schools. On Nov. 27, 1919 she was married in Monticello to Rudolph Schilt. They lived in Monroe until 1927 and then moved to Marshall. After living there 10 years, they returned to Monroe, in 1937.

Surviving are the widower; a son, Hollis R. Schilt, 2032 17th Ave., Monroe; a daughter, Mrs. Ray (Hollean) Pedersen, Plymouth, Mich.; two brothers, Fred W. Moser, Monticello, and Peter, Pittsville; two sisters, Mrs. Henry H. Freitag, New Glarus, and Mrs. Josephine Wasrud, Iola, and nine grandchildren. Her father died July 24, 1939 and her mother. March 21, 1946. A brother died at the age of six.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday (Aug. 24) in the Voegeli Funeral Home in Monticello. Rev. Calvin P. Fischer, St. John's United Church of Christ of Monroe, is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery at Monticello.
