### **Fred Schilt, 76, Monticello, Dies**

Fred Schilt, 76, Dutton, Mont., died at 7:10 last night in the home of his sister, Mrs. Joe J. Voegeli, Monticello, after a long illness. He had been staying at the Voegeli home for the past seven months.

He was born in Monroe April 2, 1878, the son of Gottfried and Barbara Wuethrich Schilt. He attended schools at Monticello.

He was married Sept. 25, 1907, to Jennie McGowan at Great Falls, Mont. He had been a rancher at Dutton since 1900 and lived there until seven months ago.

In addition to his sister, Mr. Schilt leaves three brothers, John, Sioux Falls, S. D., Rudolph, Monroe, and Jacob, Mendota, Ill. He was preceded by his wife in 1935.

He was a member of the Moose Lodge, Shelby, Mont., and was active in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, Monticello, while here.

Services will be held Monday at 2 p. m. in the Voegeli funeral home with Rev. Lynn F. B. Tschudy, New Glarus, officiating in the absence of Rev. A. R. Achtemeier. Burial will be in Highland cemetery, Monticello. Friends may call at the funeral home after 10 a. m. Sunday.
