

Christ E. Schmid

Oct. 5, 1891 - April 17, 1986

Christ E. Schmid, 94, former rural Monticello, died Thursday, April 17, 1986, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe.

Born in Washington Township, Green County, Oct. 5, 1891, he was the son of Christian and Sophia Leuenberger Schmid. He attend the Dividing Ridge Rural School. He married the former Bertha S. Stauffacher, May 29, 1924.

They farmed in Adams Township on the Aeroplane Stock Farm. After the death of his wife in 1959, he moved to Postville until 1977, when he went to Pleasant View. He was a member of the Washington Reformation Church, a lifetime member of the Holstein-Friesian Association and a member of the Turner Hall Schwing Club. He was also the state Swiss wrestling champion in the early 1920s.

Survivors include three sons, Robert L., rural Blanchardville; Glenn H, rural Monticello; and Henry L., Monroe; two daughters, Mrs. Jerry (Marion L.) Hagar, Tomahawk and Suzanne B. Kempenski, Milwaukee; 22 grandchildren and 21 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife in Sept. 1959, one son, Alvin C. in Sept 1978, and a brother, Ad Schmid.

Funeral services were held Monday at Washington Reformation Church, Monticello, with the Rev. Dan Herman officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.
