Mrs. Fred J. Schmid, 70, Albany, died at 12:35 a.m. today in St. Clare hospital where she had been a patient since Feb. 27. She had been ill at home 10 days previously for a heart condition.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Sharer funeral home at Albany. Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, will officiate. Burial will be in Hillcrest cemetery at Albany. Friends may call at the funeral home Monday afternoon and evening.

Mrs. Schmid, the former Katherine Walmer, daughter of Fred and Eunice Sadler Walmer, had been a lifelong resident of the Monticello-Albany area. She was born June 10, 1888. She and Fred J. Schmid were married Jan. 1, 1908. For several years, the Schmidts farmed in the county, moving to Albany 16 years ago. Mr. Schmid retired as an oil truck operator in 1955.

She was a member of the Zwingli church at Monticello, a past noble grand of Juaneta Rebekah lodge and a past president of the Past Noble Grands.

Surviving are her husband; a son, Ivan, Janesville; five brothers, Lee and Robert Walmer, Beloit; Ray, Ft. Atkinson; Bernard, Janesville, and Oliver, Brodhead; a sister, Mrs. J. W. Gunn, Kissimmee, Fla.; four grandchildren, and one great-grandchild. A son, Merlyn, Monticello, preceded her in death.
