Rites for Former Village Resident

Funeral services for Mrs. John Schoenenberger, 73 years. of age, Janesville, a native of Washington township and a former Monticello resident, who passed away early Saturday in a Madison hospital, were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon at the Overton funeral home, Janesville.

The Rev. Sidney Lewis, associate pastor of Cargill Methodist church, Janesville, officiated, and burial was in Milton Lawns Memorial park, Janesville.

Mrs. Schoenenberger, who had been a patient in the hospital for two weeks, submitted to an operation last week Tuesday. She had suffered several strokes over a period of years.

The former Ida Wittenwyler, she was born in Washington township, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Wittenwyler. In 1918 she was united in marriage to John Schoenenberger. They resided in Monticello for several years, Mr. Schoenenberger having been cheese maker at the factory now known as the Monticello Swiss cheese factory. They moved to a farm near Janesville in 1928, where they resided until their retirement several years ago.

Surviving are her husband; two sons, Dr. K. R. Schoenenberger, Evansville, and Dr. E. E. Schoenenberger, Chicago; one brother, Matt B. Wittenwyler, Monticello, and two grandchildren.
