Fred Schrepfer, 82, Local Native, Dies

Funeral services for Fred Schrepfer, 82, well known Belleville area farmer and native of Monticello, who died Sunday in St. Clare hospital, where he was admitted Oct. 13 as a medical patient, were held at 2 p. m. Wednesday in the First United Church of Christ, Belleville.

The Rev. Howard Beil officiated and burial was in the Belleville cemetery.

Mr. Schrepfer was born Nov. 4, 1882, in Monticello, the son of Paul and Rosina Rhyner Schrepfer. He attended the Monticello public schools. At the age of 19 he moved to the Dayton area with his parents. On Feb. 17, 1910, he was married to Caroline Mellenberger, who preceded him in death in 1942.

He was a member of the First United Church of Christ, Belleville; a director for the Citizen's State Bank, Belleville, since 1924; served on the Exeter town board from 1934 to 1960, and on the West Dayton school board from 1910 to 1960.

Survivors include a son, Paul, Belleville; three daughters, Mrs. Otto Puempel, New Glarus, Mrs. William Fahey, Belleville, and Mrs. Gordon Sardeson, Adams-Friendship; one sister, Mrs. William R. Wild, Belleville; 10 grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.
