

Isaac Schultz

June 10, 1890 - March 11, 1981

Isaac Schultz, 90, former Monticello resident, died Wednesday, March 11, in a Monroe Nursing home following a short illness. He had been a resident there since April 16, 1980.

Born in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, on June 10, 1890, he was the son of Lemuel and Anna Babler Schultz. He attended Monticello schools. He was married to the former Louise Rose Marty on Nov. 27, 1913. He was a retired carpenter, having lived in New Glarus and Monticello.

Survivors are three sons, Robert E., Vernon F. and Adrian M., all of Madison; four grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Friday, March 13 in Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge, Monticello. Paul Kirker, intern youth minister, officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello. Preceding him in death were his wife. in 1969, his parents, a grandson Donald Schultz in 1969; a brother, Jake, 1964, and two sisters, Mrs, Fannie Marty, 1960, and Mrs. Anna Wallmer, 1977.
