Jake L. Schultz, 79, Succumbs; Services Held Here Saturday

Funeral services for Jake L. Schultz, 79 years of age, native of Mt. Pleasant township and a life-long resident of this area, who died at 5:30 a. m. Thursday at the farm home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. John Daubert, northeast of the village, were held at 2 Saturday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were John L. Altmann, Clarence Blumer, Arthur Boss, Fred Minder, Emory Silver and William Wendt.

Mr. Schultz had experienced failing health for an extended period of time. An illness from a heart condition began on Dec. 2, 1963. At that time he was hospitalized for 18 weeks, This fall he was again a hospital patient in October and November, returning home for Thanksgiving.

Mr. Schultz was born in Mt. Pleasant township Jan. 4, 1885, the son of Lemuel and Anna Babler Schultz. He attended the Oak Shade rural school. On Jan. 23, 1906, he was united in marriage in Monticello to Livona Pierce. After their marriage they farmed in Mt. Pleasant township. and had operated the present farm since 1910, They retired to the village in 1955.

Mr. Schultz was assessor for Mt. Pleasant township for 27 years and was clerk of the Zentner school district for many years. He is survived by one son, Raymond L. Schultz, Ft. Wayne, Ind.; one daughter, Mrs. John Daubert, Mt, Pleasant township; one brother, Isaac Schultz, Madison; one sister, Mrs. Oliver Walmer, Brodhead; three grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife on May 1, 1964, and one sister, Mrs, Albert Marty, March 19, 1961.
