FATHER OF NEW GLARUS MAN IS SMALLPOX VICTIM

Burial at Monticello

The remains of Lem Schultz, father of Isaac Schultz, of New Glarus, were brought to Monticello, on Tuesday for burial in the Highland cemetery there. The private funeral services which were held immediately upon the arrival of the body, were conducted by Rev. Muehlmeier.

Mr. Schultz passed away at Rice Lake where he had been seriously ill with the dread disease for more than a week. The deceased was 61 years of age,

For several years Mr. Schultz had lived in the northern part of the state when he was engaged to helping build railroads, when stricken he was superintending 50 men who were constructing a railroad north of Winters.

He is survived by two sons and two daughters, Isaac of New Glarus, Jacob of Monticello; Mrs. Albert Marty, of Monticello; Mrs. Oliver Wallman of Brodhead. His wife died about four years ago.
