

## **Hedwig Frances Anna Schulz**

**April 10, 1889 – September 2, 1950**

### **Mrs. Albert Schulz, 61, Mt. Pleasant, is Called; Rites Held Native of Germany Dies Saturday A. M. After Long Illness**

Funeral services for Mrs. Albert Schulz, 61 years of age, a resident of Mt. Pleasant township for nearly 40 years, who passed away at 5:30 Saturday morning in the St. Clare hospital, following a lingering illness, were held at 2 Tuesday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Schulz had been in declining health for several years and had been hospitalized several times.

### **Native of Germany**

Hedwig Frances Anna Ruenger was a native of Germany, having been born in Norenberg April 10, 1889, the daughter of Herman and Otilia Krueger Ruenger. She attended school in her native land and was confirmed there. On Feb. 12, 1912, she was united in marriage in Norenberg to Albert Schulz. The couple came to America immediately after their marriage and had always lived in Mt. Pleasant township.

Mrs. Schulz was a devoted member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church and a very faithful member of its Sunday school.

She is survived by her husband; one son, Herman, at home; four daughters, Mrs. Dale Atkinson, Mrs. Harold Albertson, Albany, Mrs. Howard Gould, Belleville, and Mrs. Lawrence Huntley, Monticello; one brother, Paul Ruenger, Brodhead; and 11 grandchildren. She was preceded in death by one daughter, Ella, and two brothers and one sister in Germany.
