Dec. 9, 1898 - April 13, 1979

Mrs. Lester E. (Mabel I.) Schulz, 80, formerly of Monroe died Friday, April. 13 at the New Glarus Home, where she had been a resident since April of 1975.

She was the former Mabel Irene Clarno and was born Dec. 9, 1898, in Orangeville, Ill., the daughter of John and Sarah Decker Clarno. On June 24, 1919, she was married to Lester E. Schulz in Rockford, Ill. They farmed in the Monticello area until his death in 1954. She moved to Monroe in 1955 and was a cook at the Crystal Tower restaurant.

Funeral services were held Monday, April 16 in the Stuessy Funeral Home, Monroe. Rev. John Francis of the United Methodist Church officiated. Burial was in the Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, two sons in infancy; a brother, John at age 13, and two sisters, Mayme Lausch and Myrtle Hoot.
