Former Local Man Dies; Rites Today Emil Schweizer. succumbs Sunday at Waukegan Hospital

Emil Schweizer, 56 years of age, a resident of Monticello for a number of years, but who had made his home on a farm near Antioch, Ill., for the past several months, passed away Sunday at a hospital in Waukegan, Ill., where he had submitted to major surgery a few days before.

Mr. Schweizer had suffered from asthma for many years.

Mr. Schweizer was a native of Switzerland, coming to the United States 24 years ago. He farmed in the Monroe vicinity for a number of years and came to Monticello with his family six or seven years ago. While a resident of Monticello he was agent for a livestock feed company and was also employed at the New Glarus condensery. Last September he moved with his family to a small farm near Antioch, Ill.

Surviving, besides the widow, are one daughter, Anne, and a son, Roy, both at home; three brothers and five sisters,
