E. M. Selleck, Native Of Monticello, Dies

Ernest Meade Selleck, longtime resident of Kinnickinnic township, near River Falls, passed away at the River Falls nursing home late Monday evening, July 12.

He was born in Monticello on July 4, 1877, where he grew to manhood and received his education. He was united in marriage to Zanna B. Howe of Monroe, on Dec. 18, 1900. He moved his family to a farm near Roberts, Wis., in the fall of 1903. They resided there for nine years before moving to the present home in Kinnickinnic, where they have resided for 53 years.

He held the offices of assessor and treasurer of the Town of Kinnickinnic for over 30 years.

He is survived by his wife; one son, Arthur E.; three daughters, Mrs. Richard Price (Vera), Mrs. William Mueller (Ruth), and Mrs. Donald Taylor (Edith); 14 grandchildren, and 18 great-grandchildren.

His parents, one brothers and three sons preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held at 2 p. m. Thursday, July 15, from the Segerstrom funeral home in River Falls, and interment was in Greenwood cemetery there.
