

Conrad Senn

Dec. 2, 1900 - March 30, 1980

Funeral services were held Wednesday, April 2, for Conrad Senn, 79, rural Monticello, who died Sunday, March 30, at St. Clare Hospital after an extended illness. He had been hospitalized since March 19.

Born in Eschenz, Canton Thurgau, Switzerland, on Dec. 2, 1900, he was the son of Jacob and Anna Schmid Senn. He came to the United States in 1913, settling in Green County and finished his education in rural schools in Exeter Township. On Aug. 5, 1930, he married Bertha Hammer at Madison.

They farmed in both Green and Dane Counties. Since retiring in 1972, he has resided with his wife in Washington Township near Monticello.

Survivors are his widow; six sons, Robert and David, Madison, William, Cottage Grove, Donald, Evansville, John, Belleville, and Stephen, Denver, Colo.; five daughters, Mrs. Jack (Beth) Foist, Mrs. Charles (Dorothy) Kennedy, Carol Dreager, Kathryn and Jean, all of Madison; two sisters, Anna and Emma in Switzerland; seven grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Services were held at the Zwingli Church. Memorial Lounge, Monticello, with Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.
