Orville T. Slagel, 63 years of age, Pontiac, Mich. father of Mrs. Robert M. Dodd, Monticello, died at 3 p. m. Sunday at the Veterans hospital in Dearborn, Mich., after an extended illness. He had been a patient at the hospital for more than a month.

Born at Panama, Ill, Oct. 31, 1898, he was the son of Samuel and Adeline Kessinger Slagel. He was a building contractor and had resided in Pontiac for the past 15 years. He was a veteran of World War I and served at the Mexican border and in Europe.
