Mrs. Ellen Soper, 84, Dies Sunday Night

Funeral services for Mrs. Ellen Soper, 84 years of age, lifelong resident of New Glarus township, who passed away at 11 p. m. Sunday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Orville Bleiler, Postville, with whom she had been visiting for the past several weeks, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Zentner funeral home, New Glarus.
