

**Catherine Stauffacher**  
**June 23, 1850 - October 21, 1942**

MONROE — Mrs. Catherine Stauffacher, 92, died at her home, 911 10th st., Monroe, Wednesday.

She was born at Engi, Canton Glarus, Switzerland, June 23, 1850. Her maiden name was Catherine Luchsinger. At the age of two years she came with her parents to New Glarus. On Dec. 7, 1871, she was married to Jacob Anton Stauffacher at Dutch Hollow. After marriage she lived on a farm in Dutch Hollow until 1909, when she came to live in Monroe.

She is survived by three sons, Alvin, Wolsey, S. D.; Gilbert, Kenosha; and Lawrence, Monroe; a daughter, Mrs. Anna Bleiler, Salem, Ill.; a sister, Mrs. O. L. Luchsinger, Brodhead; nine grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.

She was a member of the Immanuel Evangelical church, Monroe.

The funeral will be held at 1:30 p. m. Friday in the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home, with the Rev. Alvin C. Rabehl officiating. Burial will be in the Dutch Hollow cemetery.
