"Butterfly Lady" Rites Conducted

Services for Mrs. Emil W. (Della) Stauffacher, 77, Monroe, were held at 1:30 p.m, today in the Stuessy funeral home, Rev. Gerritt Mouw, pastor of the Union Presbyterian church, officiating. Burial was in Dutch Hollow cemetery, Sylvester Township.
