Mathias H. Stauffacher 1887 - October 8, 1974

Matt H. Stauffacher, 97, Monroe, died Oct. 8, in St. Clare Hospital, 10 minutes after he had been admitted from the Monroe Manor Nursing Home where he had been since July 10.

Stauffacher had been a director of the American Dairy Assn., of Wisconsin, served on several committees of the Green County Farm Bureau for many years, and was a long time director and officer of the Wisconsin Swiss and Limburger Cheese Producers Assn. He was a director of the Green County Fair Board from 1923-34.

Stauffacher was born in Mt. Pleasant Township, in 1887, one of 12 children of Dietrich and Katherine Anna Norder Stauffacher. He married Adell Elmer, Dec. 31, 1912, in Monticello, with the late Rev. A. Muehlmeier officiating. He had worked many years at Schmidt Shoe Store. In the depression years of the 1930's he and Mrs. Stauffacher farmed their Mt. Pleasant Township farm that they owned for sometime. They moved back to Monroe in 1940.

His widow, Adell, is the only immediate survivor.
