

ELLEN V. STAUFFER

Ellen V. Stauffer age 102, of New Glarus, formerly of Monticello, died Tuesday, January 29, 2002 at the New Glarus Home.

Ellen was born January 7, 1900, in New Glarus Township, Green County, Wisconsin, the daughter of Jacob and Elsbeth (Hoesly) Ott. Ellen graduated from New Glarus High School in 1918 and married Chris M. Stauffer on March 29, 1921 at the New Glarus Parsonage. He preceded her in death in October of 1963. Following her marriage, Ellen lived in Monticello until entering the New Glarus Home in 1992. She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where she served as past President of the Zwingli Women's Guild, past President of the Women's Missionary Society, and was a member of the Ladies Aid Society. Mrs. Stauffer was a past Worthy Matron of the former Monticello Order of the Eastern Star, a member of the Daughters of the Nile of Madison, and was a 60 year member of the Elmer Ross Women's Relief Corps.

She is survived by nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband she was preceded in death by a daughter, Ruth Leach in August, 2001; a brother, Alvin Ott in February, 1984; and a sister, Alda Kubly in November, 1963.

Funeral services were held Friday, February 1, 2002, at Zwingli United Church of Christ Monticello. Rev. Lawrence Balleine and Rev. Charles Workman officiated. Interment was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

A memorial fund will be established in Ellen's name for Zwingli United Church of Christ or the New Glarus Home.
