Mrs. Steinmann Dies at Madison

MONTICELLO — Mrs. George C. Steinmann, 78, Monticello, died yesterday at 10:15 p.m. in the Methodist hospital, Madison, after a long illness. She had been hospitalized since July.

Mrs. Steinmann, daughter of Erasmus and Ellen O'Rourke Kilgore, was born in Green County on June 17, 1882. The former Inez Kilgore and George C. Steinmann were married Sept. 2, 1903, in Monticello. He was a partner for the People's Supply General Store now known as the W. E. Blum Store, Monticello.

Survivors are a son, Gordon K., Madison; two brothers, Forrest M. Kilgore and Clyde E. Kilgore, both of Madison; three sisters, Mrs. A. R. Nottingham, St. Petersburg, Fla.; Mrs. Herbert Lehman, Madison, and Mrs. Elmer Goldsmith, Indianapolis, Ind., one grandchild and one great-grandchild.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Dec. 13, 1942; two sisters, Mrs. Matt Duerst, Monroe, 1931, and Mrs. Grace Aldrich, Black Earth, 1959.

Mrs. Steinmann was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, its Aid society and the Order of the Eastern Star, Monticello.

Services will be held Wednesday at 2 p.m. in the Voegeli funeral home. Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of Zwingli church, will officiate and burial will be in Highland cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 4 p.m. tomorrow.
