

Albert F. Strasser
Feb. 5, 1891 - June 6, 1980

Albert F. Strasser, 89, Monticello, died Friday, June 6, at the New Glarus Home, where he had entered three weeks prior.

Born Feb. 5, 1891, he was the son of Jake and Rose Boss Strasser in Sylvester Township. He was married to Nellie Kryder on Sept. 25, 1915, in Rockford, Ill. They farmed near Juda until 1928 and then moved to Monticello. Strasser worked for Karlen Lumber Yard and the Karlen Garage until his retirement in 1963.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

During his retirement, he was often seen feeding ducks at the Monticello Lake.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. William (Marion) Lauber, Monticello; one sister, Mrs. Ben (Emma) Jenny, Monroe; three grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Monday, June 9, in the Stuessy Funeral Home, Monroe. Rev. Charles Workman officiated, and burial was in Greenwood Cemetery, Monroe.

He was preceded in death by parents, his wife in 1962; one son, Ralph, 1968; one great-granddaughter; two brothers, Ed and Jake; four sisters, Mrs. Albert Munz, Mrs. Louise Dollan, Mrs. Gottlieb Losberger and Mrs. Mary Edwards.
