NICHOLAUS STREIFF DIES AT HOME OF DAUGHTER

A stroke of apoplexy caused the sudden death of Nicholas Streiff at the home of his daughter, Mrs, Casper Rhyner, two miles northeast of Monticello, on Friday morning.

Mr. Streiff had made his home there for several months and had been assisting with the farm work. Thursday evening he had milked as usual and was still about his work in the barn when he was stricken. Shortly after midnight he died.

Mr. Streiff was born in New Glarus, a son of Mr. and Mrs, Jacob Streiff, May 19, 1868. He grew up in his home here. Thirty-two years ago he was married to Miss Katherine Streiff, They lived on a farm near Monticello for ten years. Mrs. Streiff died about 24 years ago.

Four daughters and one son survive him. They are Mrs. Martha Knute, Winslow; Mrs. Julia Meier, Mt. Horeb; Mrs. Grace Husted, Ridgeway; Mrs. Mary Rhyner, Monticello and Nicholas Jr. living im South Dakota, One son, Jacob, a twin to Mrs. Meier died several years ago, He also leaves 9 grandchildren, one sister. Ellen Streiff, two brothers Jacob and Peter.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the Zentner Undertaking Parlor with burial at the Reformed Cemetery.
