

Esais Stuessy

Oct. 29, 1837 - Feb. 18, 1925

Esais Stuessy, mention of whose death was in last week's issue was born Oct. 29, 1837 in Haslen, Canton Glarus, Switzerland, and was baptized the same day. He attended the local schools and was confirmed in 1855. On Nov. 3, 1859 he was united in marriage with Barbara Hoesly. They came to America in 1869 and settled on a farm three miles southwest of New Glarus.

Here they resided until four years ago when they went to Monticello and made their home with a daughter Mrs. J. J. Streiff.

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon at the Streiff home at Monticello and burial took place at the Reformed Cemetery in New Glarus. He reached the high age of 87 years, 3 months and 19 days.

He is survived by his widow, one son, Fred W. Stuessy of New Glarus, one daughter, Mrs. J. J. Streiff of Monticello, 8 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.
