Funeral services for Edward H. Theiler, 77, a native of Monticello, who died Thursday, were held at 1:30 p. m. Saturday in the Rosman-Uehling-Kinzer Central Chapel in Beloit.

The Rev. Arthur Snow of the Second Congregational church, Beloit, officiated, and burial was in Eastlawn cemetery, Beloit.

Mr. Theiler had suffered a heart attack at his home in Beloit and was dead on arrival at the hospital.

Mr. Theiler, a retired electrical contractor, has been a resident of Beloit since 1943. He first farmed in Washington township and later operated an electrical business in Monroe before moving to Beloit.

He was born Feb. 3, 1888, in Monticello, the son of Huldrich and Rosina Blumer Theiler. On Oct. 19, 1905, he was married in Monticello to Mary Zweifel.

Mr. Theiler was a member of Second Congregational church.

Surviving are his widow; two daughters, Mrs. Marie Baebler and Mrs. Alfred A. Yunker, both of Beloit; four sisters, Mrs. Louis Pfund, Mrs. Reeve B. Bokemeier and Miss Clara B. Theiler, all of Monroe, and Mrs. William J. Press, Beloit; two brothers Rinehart, Madison, and Fred, Beloit; two granddaughters, and six great-grandchildren.
