Mrs. Edw. Theiler, Former Resident of Community, Stricken

Funeral services for Mrs. Edward H. Theiler, 86 years of age, Beloit, who died on Wednesday afternoon of last week at the Beloit Memorial hospital, were held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in the Rosman-Uehling-Kinzer Funeral Home, Beloit.

Burial was in East Lawn cemetery, Beloit.

Mary Zweifel was born in New Glarus on March 20, 1883, the daughter of Fred and Barbara Adank Zweifel. On Oct. 19, 1905, she was united in marriage to Edward H. Theiler, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. They farmed in Washington township until moving to Monroe in 1925. Mr. Theiler operated an electrical appliance and service business in Monroe until 1943, when the couple moved to Beloit. Mr. Theiler continued in the electrical business in Beloit for a number of years. He died on Nov. 4, 1965.

Mrs. Theiler was a member of Second Congregational church in Beloit and had been a member of the Aid society of Washington Reformation church for many years.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Marie Baebler and Mrs. Eldred Yunker, both of Beloit; a brother, Fred Zweifel, Monticello; two granddaughters, and six great-grandchildren.

A brother, Joseph Zweifel, New Glarus, preceded her in death.
