Mrs. Paul (Leona) Thomann, 78, N7926 County X, Belleville, died Thursday, Nov. 26, 1987, at Monroe Manor Nursing Home.

The former Leona Christina Gilbertson was born in Albany Township, Green County, Dec. 3, 1908, the daughter of Theodore and Sarah Dena (Kittleson) Gilbertson. She graduated from the Norwegian Settlement Rural School.
