Mrs. Julia Thorp Dies at Residence

Mrs. Julia Thorp, 88, died today at 3 a. m. in the residence of her sister, Miss Lydia Schulz, with whom she had made her home for the last 12 years. Death followed a lingering illness of more than a year.

Mrs. Thorpe was born in Stoughton Aug. 16, 1860, the daughter of August and Lizzie Nanka Schulz. The family moved later to South Dakota where she was married to Henry Thorp. The couple resided at Mitchell, S. D., for many years prior to Mr. Thorp's death 20 years ago.

She leaves two sisters, Miss Lydia of the home and Mrs. Mary Klindt of Gannvalley, S. D. Another sister, Mrs. Lizzie Cole, Gannvalley, and six brothers, John, Fred, Samuel, Andrew, Frank and Edward, preceded her in death.
