Former Mt. Pleasant Resident Succumbs

Mrs. Eugene Truax Called In Minnesota Hospital At Age of 79

Mrs. Eugene Truax, 79 years of age, Vesta Minn., native of Mt. Pleasant township and a resident of Green county for nearly 50 years, passed away Wednesday, Aug. 25, in the Clinic hospital, Tracy, Minn., from the effects of a cerebral hemorrhage. She had been ill for about five months.

The funeral services were held Sunday afternoon, Aug. 28, at the home and at the Vesta Presbyterian church, Rev. Robert Alexander officiating. Attending the funeral from Green county were Mrs. John Truax, Monticello, and Mrs. Emil Johnson, Albany.

Mary Jane Estes was born Dec. 13, 1863, in Mt. Pleasant township, about five miles southeast of Monticello, the daughter of Andrew and Anna Maria Estes. She was married to Eugene Truax on Feb. 22, 1886, the ceremony taking place in Monroe. They farmed in Green county until 1909, when they moved to Lyon county, Minn. Six years later they located on a farm east of Milroy, Minn., where they made their home until moving to Vesta in 1926.

Survivors include the husband; two sons, George Truax, Marshall, Minn., and Howard Truax, Vesta, Minn.; one daughter, Mrs. Louis Kotval, Lucian, Minn.; two sisters, Mrs. Sarah Goodell, Waterloo, Ta., and Mrs. Ellen Fromholtz, Beloit, Wis, and six grandchildren.
