July 13, 1949 - Aug. 20, 1950
Victim of Leukemia

Monticello — (Times Special) —Judith Ann Updike, Adams township, year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Melvin Updike, died at 8:20 a. m. yesterday at the Wisconsin General hospital, Madison, where she had been a leukemia patient since June 12 when her illness was diagnosed. Numerous blood transfusions were unsuccessful in overcoming the disease.

The child, daughter of Melvin and Hazel Duerst Updike, was born July 13, 1949, in Monroe and had been baptized into the church.

Surviving are the parents; one brother, Richard Eugene, 3, and Janice Marie, 7; her paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Updike, Janesville, and her maternal grandmother, Mrs. Anna Duerst, New Glarus.

Last rites will be at 2 p. m. tomorrow in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church with Rev. Paul C. Kehle, pastor of St. John's Evangelical church Monroe, officiating in the absence of Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, regular church pastor. Burial will be in Highland cemetery with four cousins as pallbearers,
