Mrs. Euphemia Urben, 72, Former Local Lady, Dies

Mrs. Euphemia Urben, aged 72, residing at 714 Huron Hill, Madison, and a former Monticello resident, passed away Monday evening while enroute to a hospital after suffering a heart attack at her home.

Mrs. Urben had been feeling well until Monday evening.

Born in Monticello

Euphemia Freitag was born in Monticello. In March, 1904, she was united in marriage to John Urben, a cheese dealer here, who passed away in 1916.

Mrs. Urben continued to reside in Monticello until 1923, when she moved to Madison with her son Walter, who is now superintendent of the Mendota State hospital.

She is survived by her son; four grandsons; one sister, Mrs. Edwin F. Duerst, New Glarus; and three brothers, J. M. Freitag, Monticello, and J. U. Freitag and Henry, Freitag, New Glarus.
