Mrs. Herman Voegeli, 54, Adams Township, Succumbs Friday

Funeral services for Mrs. Herman Voegeli, 54 years of age, Adams township, who passed away at 10:45 a. m. Friday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, as the result of a heart condition, with which she had been afflicted for many years, were held at 1:30 Monday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Mrs. Voegeli had been hospitalized on many occasions and last entered the St. Clare hospital on Sept. 9.

Marie Grossen, daughter of Emil and Emma Dummermuth Grossen, was born in Lafayette county on Sept. 17, 1906. She attended rural schools. On Dec. 1, 1925, she was united in marriage to Herman E. Voegeli, the ceremony taking place in Monticello. They had since farmed in Adams township,
