

Rosa Voegeli
July 3, 1867- January 14, 1965

MONTICELLO — Mrs. Rosa Voegeli, 97, Monticello's oldest resident, died at 4:35 p.m. Thursday in the Four Winds Manor, Verona, where she had made her home the past two years. Death was due to old age complications but Mrs. Voegeli had been active and in good health until her death.

The former Rosa Figi was born in New Glarus July 3, 1867, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Figi. She was married to Baltz Voegeli Feb. 17, 1885, and they farmed the area until retiring and moving to Monticello in 1913, He died in 1931. Mrs. Voegeli was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and its Ladies Aid; the Royal Neighbors, John Ross Chapter, Women's Relief Corps, and the GUGG Society.

Surviving are four sons, Alfred, of Monroe, Emil and Leon, both of Monticello, and Edward, of Miami, Fla.; six grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Zwingli Church, the Rev. J. Allen Mittler officiating. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery.
