David P. Wahl, 25, rural Monticello, died Sunday, April 8, 1984, in a house fire at his home in Mt. Pleasant Township.

The son of Myron and Donna Jean Johnson Wahl, he was born in Monroe on Feb. 21, 1959. He was a 1977 graduate of Monticello High School, and had owned and operated the Wahl Welding Company in Monticello, and was also employed at Laidlaw Corp., Monticello, where he was a press operator.

He was a member of St. Victor's Catholic Church, Monroe, and a former member of the Monroe Machine and Welding tug-of-war team.
