DEATH BRINGS RELIEF.

Mrs. Elizabeth Weissmiller died Friday at Mendota hospital, where she had received treatment since last July. The remains were brought to Monticello Saturday and taken to the old homestead west of there for the funeral which was held from there Tuesday at 12 o'clock and later from the Reformed Church of the town of Washington.

The deceased was the widow of Jacob Weissmiller, who died two years ago. Seven years ago she suffered from concussion of the brain by being injured in a runaway and the death of her husband so affected her that her mind became unbalanced. Previous to being sent to Mendota her children had her cared for at the Wauwatosa sanitarium for four weeks, but she grew worse and had to be removed to Mendota.

She was 63 years of age and was a lady who was well known and most highly esteemed. In her misfortune very great sympathy was felt for her by her numerous friends. Her case was without hope from the start and her death was indeed a relief from the misery that she has long suffered and which has been deeply distressing to her children and relatives. She was the mother of eight children, six of whom survive her.
