

Jefferson Fayette “Fay” Wescott II

June 28, 1890 - August 9, 1975

J. Fay Wescott, 85, Albany, brother of Mrs. Ernest Schlittler, Monticello, died unexpectedly in his home early Saturday morning, August 9. He was born in Monticello on June 28, 1890, and attended Monticello schools and the Monroe Business College. He was married in Rockford to Alta Gwen Watts on July 22, 1913, and clerked in a store in Albany for many years.

Other survivors are a daughter, Mrs. John (Eva) Farberg, Carpentersville, Ill.; one grandson, Dean Arnold, Evansville; and one granddaughter, Cindy Farberg, Carpentersville, Ill.

Preceding him in death were his wife, in 1971, a son, Frank, in 1935, and a brother and a sister.

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, August 12, in the Gohlke-Sharer Funeral Home in Albany with the Rev. Quinton Meracle of the United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in the Hill Crest Cemetery, Albany.
