Mrs, Alfred Wettach, Age 71, Dies Sunday After Long Illness

Funeral services for Mrs. Alfred Wettach, 71 years of age, Monticello, who died at 5:45 a. m. Sunday at a Brodhead nursing home from an illness which had its inception in 1958, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon at the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

Mrs. Wettach had been a patient at the nursing home since 1959.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were August Fiez, New Glarus, John Saxer, Monroe, Clarence Holcomb, Robert Holcomb, Sr., Charles R. Marty and Ernest Schuerch.

Babette Loppacher was born at Trogen, Canton Appenzell, Switzerland, Nov. 15, 1889, the daughter of Jacob and Elizabeth Faessler Loppacher.. On Feb. 17, 1920, she was united in marriage at Trogen to Alfred Wettach. That spring they came to America, settling in Green county. They farmed west of Monticello and a short distance north of the village until retiring to Monticello in 1947,

Mrs. Wettach was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, John, Monticello, and Jacob, Belleville; one daughter, Mrs. Robert J. Coffey, Madison; five grandchildren, and five nieces, four of them in Switzerland, and Mrs. Robert Winzeler, Cincinnati, Ohio.

She was preceded in death by one sister.
